General Pest Preparation

(Roaches, Ants, Silverfish, Earwigs, Sow-Bugs, Pill Bugs, Carpet Beetles, Fleas, Crickets, Ticks, & Spiders)

Interior

- 1. Remove all items in infested cabinets in the kitchen and bathrooms
- 2. Place the items on the kitchen table and/or place the items in the center of the floor in another room and cover with plastic.
- 3. Move furniture and other items from walls as well as empty all infested closets to apply application.
- 4. Everyone must vacate the property for a period of 4-6 hours
- 5. Remove all animals (dogs, cats, reptiles, & etc.) for a period of 4-6 hours
- 6. Birds must vacate the property for a period of 24 hours.
- 7. Place plants (in the house) outside for 6-8 hours.
- 8. Cover and unplug filter to fish tanks.
- 9. Leave windows and doors closed and locked.

Exterior

- 1. Mow and water the lawn before service.
- 2. Application will be more effective if you do not mow or water the lawn for at least 3 days after the treatment.
- 3. Allow access to the backyard as well as to the interior of the garage for service.
- 4. Place all pet toys and water/food bowls in a secure location prior to treatment.

German Cockroaches

- 1. Completely empty all kitchen and bathroom storage areas.
- 2. Empty chest of drawers, dresser drawers, closet shelves, & etc. if roaches are seen in bedrooms.
- 3. Place the items on the kitchen table and/or place the items in the center of the floor in another room and cover with plastic.
- 4. Move furniture and other items from walls as well as empty all infested closets to apply application.
- 5. Wipe down all cabinet shelves, counter tops, and etc. before service.
- 6. Clean top of stove (lift and clean undersides of top) and exhaust fan.
- 7. Pull out refrigerator and clean back, bottom, and floor.
- 8. Be prepared to vacate the property for 4-6 hours.

After Treatment

- 1. Remove all the dead roaches.
- 2. Do not wipe down the interior of all the cabinets and storage spaces that were treated.
- 3. Place all of the items back without the fear of contamination.
- 4. Allow 14 days for the treatment to be completely effective.
- 5. Please keep in mind that the materials the industry use does not penetrate the egg capsules. However, the materials will eliminate the young roaches after they are free from the egg capsules.

Oriental, Brown, & American Cockroaches

- 1. Remove all items from the inside of the lower cabinets in the kitchen and bathrooms.
- 2. Place the items on the kitchen table and/or place the items in the center of the floor in another room and cover with plastic.
- 3. Move furniture and other items away from walls.
- 4. Move items away from walls in garage.
- 5. Remove items and clear area around washer/dryer.
- 6. Allow 14 days for the treatment to be completely effective.

Fleas

- 1. Have pets treated the same day of service.
- 2. All carpeting (all floor surfaces) must be vacuumed and free from personal items to effectively treat all or as much carpet area (floor surfaces) as possible.
- 3. Lift pillows on couches, chairs & etc. and vacuum.
- 4. Place vacuum bag in a plastic trash bag and throw away outside.
- 5. Move furniture and personal property away from wall.
- 6. Wash pet bedding or replace it.
- 7. Wash all bed linens.

After Treatment

- 1. Vacuum carpeting (all floor surfaces) two days after service.
- 2. Vacuum carpeting (all floor surfaces) every other day for 10 days.
- 3. Place vacuum bag in a plastic trash bag and throw away outside after each use.
- 4. Allow 14 days for the treatment to be completely effective.
- 5. Please keep in mind that the materials the industry use does not penetrate the flea eggs and pupae. However, the materials will eliminate the young fleas after they are free from the eggs and pupae.
- 6. You might want to consider a regular treatment program for your animals.

Carpet Beetles

- 1. Move furniture and other items away from walls.
- 2. Remove all items in linen closets and wash / dry clean linen items.
- 3. Empty closet or chest of drawers where infestation of pests is found.
- 4. Wash/dry clean personal items.
- 5. Inspect house eaves for bird nests.

Meal Moths and Pantry Beetles

- 1. Empty pantry or cabinets where infestation of pests is found.
- 2. Place the items on the kitchen table and/or place the items in the center of the floor in another room and cover with plastic.
- 3. Wipe down interior of pantry or cabinet shelves before treatment.
- 4. Inspect cereal foods, spices, dry foods, pet foods, bird seeds, and etc. for larvae.
- 5. Place infested items in a plastic trash bag and throw it away outside.
- 6. Remove interior plants and place them outside.
